designed to build resilience, problem solving, personal reflection and self-awareness of one's values and character. This workbook is the second step of the Project and is the very toolbox needed to help create a permanent positive change to each student individually.

At the end of the course, students will participate in the last step of the Project is called the Love Project. This community service project is chosen by the students themselves and can be completed within their school or their community. Each student is now ready to give away to others what they received through the program.

As students exit the Project their outcomes show stronger emotional skills, better ability to cope through everyday challenges, character development and strengthened social connections.
